

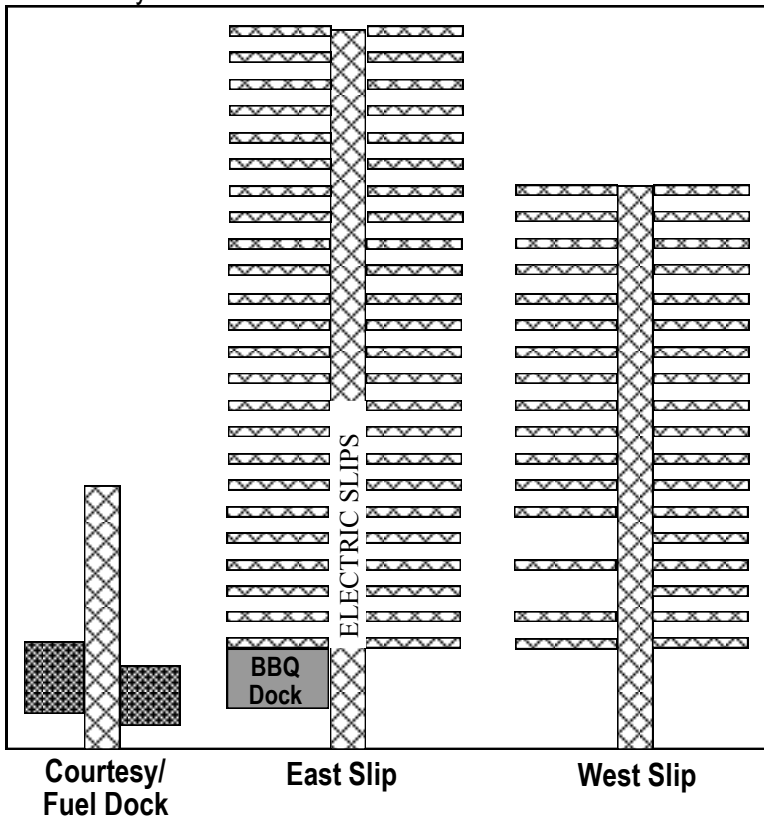

MOORINGS & SLIPS

This year, the marina will be offering 100 slips, 24 electric slips, & 80 moorings. Our policy for assigning slips and moorings is that we hold each last year full season customer's space until **March 1, 2014**. At that time, we assign any remaining moorings or slips on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority for new assignments will be the **date we receive payment**. It is important to mail your check in early to get a mooring or slip. If you have a preference for location, please note that on your contract and we will try to place you near that area. Contracts can be printed off our web site (www.carterlakemarina.com). Our price list for this season is on the back of this newsletter. Please complete your contract and return it with your payment. Please include your email address if you have one.



ADDITIONAL SERVICES

The Marina will also offer winter boat storage again in 2014 (price listed on reverse side of this page). We will continue to manage the Boat Pump Out Station, with a few changes. The pump will be relocated and reside East of the Marina courtesy dock. Customers will need to pre-set a time to access the pump station with Donald, John, or the Fuel Dock associates. There will be a nominal. If you must pump without giving prior notice to the Marina, it will be a different charge. Prices TBA. Please call the Marina with any questions.

2014 COUNTY PARK PERMITS

Larimer County Parks Department is taking a zero tolerance policy pertaining to State Boat Registration and County Vehicle/Boat Permits on boats and vehicles anywhere inside the park. County Vehicle/Boat Permits should be displayed on your vehicle windshield at all times. Permits can be purchased at the Marina starting April 1. They should be purchased PRIOR to launching your boat. State registration must be applied for from the Colorado State Parks. Larimer County Parks phone number: 970-679-4570.

WATER LEVELS

Water levels this season will be about normal all year.

The current Bureau for Reclamation operating plan show the lake to be near full around May. Water levels at the end of September will be around 63 feet from full. This is about normal for Carter Lake.

We plan on having the Marina water front up and running on April 1 this season and closing on October 31. These water levels are similar to last year.

Snow packs are below normal so far this winter, but the good news is they are improving as I write this newsletter.

NOTES FROM THE HARBOR MASTER

Spring is just around the corner and we at the Marina are gearing up for our 26th season. If you have any questions about anything, please call the Marina phone (970-667-1062) and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

It's very important to send in your contract early if you are new or requesting a new assignment, and "on time" if you were here last year and want to keep your assignment. Renewal contracts must be **received by March 1** to ensure your same spot from 2013 or to receive a new location if you were a customer last year. **Commercial operators** will also pay a 25% surcharge on moorings, slips, and winter storage fees.

Copies of the **CLM Rules & Regulations** are available in the Marina Store. Please ask for a copy when you stop in the office for your permits and Moor/Slip assignment. These rules are for the safety and enjoyment of all our customers.

For our Mooring customers, "**manned shuttle service**" hours are 9-5 Monday thru Friday and 8-6 Saturday and Sunday, Memorial day thru Labor Day; spring and fall hours are 9-5 daily. The dinghy is available "**self-service**" evenings till 10pm summer season, 8pm spring and fall. Manned shuttle service and use of the dinghy in evenings is **not** part of your mooring fee and **tipping** the shuttle operators is encouraged if you appreciated the service. **Customers misusing the dinghy may lose their privilege to use it. Never tow your boat with the CLM dinghy.** Children must be 16 years old or older to operate the CLM dinghy. Boat owners are responsible for damage done by the dinghy and to the dinghy while under your or your guests' control or use.

As a few of you learned over the years, it is important to have access to your trailer 7 days a week and sometimes quickly if you are having that "sinking" feeling. The Marina does offer trailer storage near the lake at a reasonable cost. Access to this area is controlled and Marina personnel must take your trailer down and back from the Marina area. Under non-emergency circumstances, we like 24 hours notice if you need your trailer. In an emergency, your trailer is only a phone call away. The cost is \$175 for the summer season.

The Marina also offers launch and retrieval services at the lake. We can assist you at any level in floating, pulling, stepping masts, or boat towing to and from your storage spot. Call for a quote if we can help.

Due to the new layout of the Marina area, we cannot offer summer dry storage. We will be offering winter boat storage again. Please let us know if you are interested in this service.

Please plan ahead to pump out your boat head. We ask that you give at least 24 notice for an appointment for the pump out station. Someone from our Fuel Dock **must** assist with the **locks** on the pump station. If you find you need to pump and do not have an appointment, contact the Fuel Dock staff. There will be different fees for appointments and last minute requests. Fees will be available at the Marina starting April 1.

For the safety of the Marina, we must limit the number of larger boats on our moorings and in our slips. If you are interested in a mooring, your boat must be under 28ft. For an electric slip, your boat must be 30ft or smaller, no heavier than 9,500lbs, and less than 11ft in beam. For non-electric slips, your boat must be less than 27ft. Previous customers are grandfathered in and their size will be accepted.

If you are a previous customer and want to purchase a larger boat, you must check with the Marina staff to confirm space is available. At this time, no boats over 30ft will be considered. Please call us with any questions.

All seasonal rates are based on 5 months [May-September] weather and water level permitting. Weather and water level permitting, mooring and slips will be available April 1 thru October 31. Seasonal customers receive April and October at no additional charge. Monthly customers wishing to reserve space for the summer must start their contract no later than May 1.

All rental fees are due in advance.
